The Lead Teacher shall communicate collaboratively with all families and staff, striving to become the most effective educator possible. The ideal candidate will hold a Primary Montessori Teaching Credential.

Duties and Requirements include, but are not limited to:

- Possessing an attitude which shows belief in the Montessori philosophy and pride in the work that is being done.
